Guest Speaker</b>	<p><b>Constable Emma PHELAN and Inspector Nicole ROACH</b>            Eastern Beaches Police Area Command            Overview of the crime in the Randwick Area in the last 3 months. Crime is spread fairly even across the week, break and enter offences at least 8 into residential houses, 2 into the residential area, this is a priority for the command. Steady decrease in alcohol offences. Increased focus on DV offences, especially repeat offenders.            Best advice is to not make homes and cars an easy target for criminals – be sure to lock doors and windows. If you see something report it by calling Maroubra or Randwick Station, unless it’s an emergency call 000. If it’s a chargeable offence be prepared to make a statement and give your contact details. Residents discussed increased bike racing around Clovelly, Frenchmans area – if it’s a continuing concern (very loud/very fast) start contacting police.
