The Maroubra Beach Committee is increasingly concerned about the number of dogs off leash from Mistral Point north of Mahon Pool, Mahon Pool area, Maroubra Plaza, Murrumburrah Park (end of McKeon Street), Broad arrow reserve, Beach promenade, and Maroubra Beach from the North end to the south end, on the beach and in the water.

There are several owners taking their dogs into the cafes and shops. Owners encouraging and allowing their dogs to sit on the chairs and the tables, in cafes and plaza furniture.

Major concerns are held for the health and safety of everyone. Large and small unattended dogs are being tied to furniture while owners get coffee/food, this is both a trip hazard and safety concern.

The Maroubra Beach Committee wants council officers to be more proactive with visibility and education. Health and Safety signs outside cafes showing the regulations and fines applicable to breaking the rules need to be displayed.

There needs to be stronger, regular, and visible enforcement of the rules. One compliance officer/council ranger in that location they would raise enough money to cover their salary in one day. Enforcement needs to be active at all different hours and in all the locations listed above.

A targeted campaign needs to be implemented as soon as possible.
