#### **Resolution:**

Resolution 11/24: RCC to advise if there is a maintenance schedule for clearing of stormwater drains as regular flooding occurs after heavy rain particularly in the area of Bream St bound by Mount and Brook Streets.

### **Council response:**

Randwick City Council's Drainage Engineer has carried out an inspection of the stormwater pits on Bream Street. No significant blockage was identified at the time of inspection.

Throughout 2024, Randwick City Council has experienced numerous significant rain events which have exceeded the capacity of the underground stormwater drainage system throughout the Local Government Area (LGA). In circumstances where this occurs, it is important that the excess water is stored within the road reserve to act as temporary storage which will be drained following the storm. This can often be misinterpreted as pipe blockage.

Randwick City Council's maintenance program allows for each pit to be inspected, and for works to be actioned (if required). We aim to do this once annually. In addition to this, Council's Road Services team respond to service requests which are raised at the request of residents.

Should residents notice a significant buildup of leaf litter or debris around the pits, please notify Council's customer service team who will raise a service request to be actioned.
