The following fees and security deposit are payable:

- Application fee \$248
- Fee for placement of a ground anchor into public land \$820 per anchor
- Refundable security deposit \$20,000

The refundable security deposit may be paid in the form of cash, bank cheque or bank guarantee. The security deposit will be refunded when the ground anchors have been cut at the boundary and removed or de-stressed, and any damage to public land has been rectified to the satisfaction of Council.

Relevant approvals and licences must also be obtained from all relevant Authorities, including the Roads & Maritime Services, NSW Police, Sydney Buses and Civil Aviation Authority.

Terms and conditions

- 1. There shall be no loss of support to Council's land (this includes parkland, roadway, footpath area, drainage reserve etc), as a result of excavation within the site or the installation of the ground anchors.
- 2. An assessment must be carried out on all public utility services on the site, (roadway, nature strip, footpath, public reserve or any public areas associated with and/or adjacent to the development/building works). This must include relevant information from public utility authorities and exploratory trenching or pot-holing, if necessary, to determine the position and level of service. Care shall be taken by the applicant to avoid damage to the public utility services.
- 3. Prior to the installation of any ground anchors, all relevant public utility authorities must be advised of the proposed works. The applicant must meet the full cost required by telecommunication companies, gas providers, Energy Australia, Sydney Water and any other utilities and service providers, to adjust/repair/relocate their services as required. The applicant must make the necessary arrangements with the service authority.
- 4. All works involving the anchors shall be carried out under the general supervision of a Structural Engineer or Geotechnical Engineer who must ensure that the approved plans and conditions are complied with.
- 5. The applicant shall ensure that the construction of the private structure (i.e. piling, retaining walls, etc) is carried out wholly within the site.
- 6. The proposed ground anchors shall be placed at a minimum of 2 metres below the surface at the boundary and 3 metres below the surface at the gutter invert or edge of road. The ground anchors shall not in any way, damage/interfere with existing services or future Council works.
- 7. Ground anchors are not to be cement grouted within 4 metres of the surface level of Council's road reserves.
- 8. The proposed ground anchors are to be safely de-stressed and/or removed after the construction period without causing damage to Council's land or existing services.
- 9. The Applicant is liable for damage caused by the installation, presence, de-stressing or removal of the ground anchors, including:
 - Damage to public land;
 - Damage to public land preventing future development of the land; and/or
 - Damage to existing services.

Agreement

- I/we accept full responsibility for any damage and necessary alterations to public utility services and Councils property or adjacent properties arising from the above works;
- I/we will reimburse Council for any costs incurred in restoring the area should the works be carried out in an unsatisfactory manner;
- I/we indemnify Council in respect of any claims which may arise as a result of the subject works;
- I/we accept the terms & conditions detailed on this application form.
